What is the Fife College Association Scholarship?

Who Can Apply?

This year, the Fife College Association have chosen to support full-time students at Fife College studying the following courses:

- HNC Professional Cookery
- HNC Professional Cookery (Patisserie)



There is £500 available which may be split and awarded to more than one student at the discretion of the panel.

What Can You Spend the Scholarship On?

This scholarship is to support you while you study to help with items you need for your course such cooking equipment or travel expenses. It can also be used for those looking to support their next step into further study or employment.
