

## **CARNEGIE ENTERPRISE LIMITED (SC616553)**

### **GUIDE TO INFORMATION AVAILABLE THROUGH OUR PUBLICATION SCHEME**

The Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 (the Act) requires Scottish public authorities to produce and maintain a publication scheme. Authorities are under a legal obligation to:

- publish the classes of information that they make routinely available
- tell the public how to access the information and what it might cost.

Carnegie Enterprise Ltd is a wholly owned subsidiary company of Fife College and is therefore considered to be a public authority. It is a dormant company and has never traded. It has adopted the Model Publication Scheme produced by the Scottish Information Commissioner.

The purpose of this Guide to Information is to:

- allow you to see what information is available (and what is not available) in relation to each class.
- state what charges may be applied.
- explain how you can find the information easily.
- provide contact details for enquiries and to get help with accessing the information.
- explain how to request information we hold that has not been published.

#### **Availability and formats**

The information we publish through the model scheme is, wherever possible, available on our website. We offer alternative arrangements for people who do not want to, or cannot, access the information online or by inspection at our premises. For example, we can usually arrange to send information to you in paper copy (although there may be a charge for this).

#### **Exempt information**

We will publish the information we hold that falls within the classes of information below. If a document contains information that is exempt under Scotland's freedom of information laws (for example sensitive personal information or a trade secret), we may remove or redact the information before publication but we will explain why.

## Copyright

Where Carnegie Enterprise Ltd holds the copyright in their published information, the information may be copied or reproduced without formal permission, provided that:

- it is copied or reproduced accurately
- it is not used in a misleading context, and
- the source of the material is identified

Where Carnegie Enterprise Ltd does not hold the copyright in information we publish, we will make this clear.

## Charges

This section explains when we may make a charge for our publications and how any charge will be calculated. There is no charge to view information on our website or at our premises.

We may charge for providing information to you, eg photocopying and postage, but we will charge you no more than it actually costs us to do so. We will always tell you what the cost is before providing the information to you.

Our photocopying charge per sheet of paper is shown in the tables below:

### Black and white photocopying

### Colour photocopying

Information provided on CD-Rom will be charged at 50p per computer disc.

Postage costs will be recharged at the rate we pay to send the information to you.

When providing copies of pre-printed publications, we will charge no more than the cost, pro rata, of the total print run.

We do not pass any other costs on to you in relation to our published information.

This charging schedule does not apply to our commercial publications (see Class 8 below). These items are offered for sale through our website or as part of commercial training courses and their price reflects a 'market value' which may include the cost of production.

<b>CLASS 1: ABOUT CARNEGIE ENTERPRISE LTD</b>
<b>Class description:</b> Information about Carnegie Enterprise Ltd, who we are, where to find us, how to contact us, how we are managed and our external relations
We do not hold or publish any information under this class (dormant company).

<b>CLASS 2: HOW WE DELIVER OUR FUNCTIONS AND SERVICES</b>
<b>Class description:</b> Information about our work, our strategy and policies for delivering functions and services and information for our service users.
We do not hold or publish any information under this class (dormant company).

<b>CLASS 3: HOW WE TAKE DECISIONS AND WHAT WE HAVE DECIDED</b>
<b>Class description:</b> Information about the decisions we take, how we make decisions and how we involve others.
We do not hold or publish any information under this class (dormant company).

<b>CLASS 4: WHAT WE SPEND AND HOW WE SPEND IT</b>
<b>Class description:</b> Information about our strategy for, and management of, financial resources (in sufficient detail to explain how we plan to spend public money and what has actually been spent.
We do not hold or publish any information under this class (dormant company).

<b>CLASS 5: HOW WE MANAGE OUR HUMAN, PHYSICAL AND INFORMATION RESOURCES</b>
<b>Class description:</b> Information about how we manage the human, physical and information resources of Carnegie Enterprise Ltd.
We do not hold or publish any information under this class (dormant company).

<b>CLASS 6: HOW WE PROCURE GOODS AND SERVICES FROM EXTERNAL PROVIDERS</b>
<b>Class description:</b> Information about how we procure goods and services, and our contracts with external providers
We do not hold or publish any information under this class (dormant company).

<b>CLASS 7: HOW WE ARE PERFORMING</b>
<b>Class description:</b> Information about how we perform as an organisation, and how well we deliver our functions and services
We do not hold or publish any information under this class (dormant company).

<b>CLASS 8: OUR COMMERCIAL PUBLICATIONS</b>
<b>Class description:</b> Information packaged and made available for sale on a commercial basis and sold at market value through a retail outlet e.g. bookshop, museum or research journal.
We do not hold or publish any information under this class (dormant company).

<b>CLASS 9: OUR OPEN DATA</b>
<b>Class description:</b> Open data made available by the authority as described by the Scottish Government's Open Data Resource Pack and available under an open licence.
We do not hold or publish any information under this class (dormant company).
